



2022 Herb Kohler Memorial Parade Rules

Theme: “Special People Make a Great Community”

Date: September 17th, 2022

Line Up Begins at 9:30AM

Parade Starts at 10:30AM

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1. All participants are asked to line up at their assigned position on North Broadway near KB Foods. Assigned positions will be in Thursday’s (September 15th) Daily News.
 2. Parade participants should enter the area of KB Foods from North Broadway. You will be directed from there. Please carpool when possible.
 3. Children under 6 years of age must ride on a float. Anyone younger than 6 is NOT permitted to walk in the parade.
 4. Participants are asked to put safety first. Make sure float attachments are secure, and that people riding are safe. Drivers be responsible and safe. Candy and literature can be given to spectators in a safe manner.
 5. Keep pace with the unit in front of you. Do not stop and perform along the route. You may pause to perform briefly at the announcers/judges stand.
 6. Parade line up will begin at 9:30 am. Please be in line no later than 10:15 am.
 7. The parade contest will be judged as you go by the announcer’s stand. Prizes will be awarded for 1st (\$200.00), 2nd (\$125.00), and 3rd (\$75.00) for best decorated entry. Awards will be presented on the main stage, following the parade.
 8. Horses will be assigned to the end of the parade lineup and must provide their own waste collection!
 9. Parade entries must be appropriate and family-friendly. The Tree City Fall Festival board and parade committee has the right to refuse any entry deemed inappropriate.
